When spending warm and cozy nights at home with your family this holiday season, take a moment to think about our Hartford neighbors in need – many of which are spending the holidays without heat or hot water.

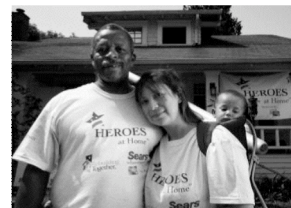
Right now, Rebuilding Together Hartford (RTH) knows of nine homes in need of either a new furnace or boiler – and it's only December. There are also 14 other homeowners awaiting our emergency assistance. This number will only increase during the coming months. RTH would like to help every homeowner, but sadly, we are unable to do so.

RTH's Emergency Home Repair program assists homeowners in need throughout the year. It is designed to help people who have an immediate need that is impacting their ability to live in warmth, safety and independence. Individuals particularly at risk for suffering in the winter months are the elderly, people living with disabilities, and families with small children.

The Emergency Home Repair program helps homeowners with critical problems such as no heat or hot water, major roof leaks, safety and/or accessibility modifications, and more. So far this year, 16 homeowners have benefited from the Emergency Home Repair program.

Here are just a few of the projects completed:

- Heating system installations – 3
- Water heater installations – 3
- Major plumbing repairs – 4
- Wheel chair ramp installation – 1
- Major stairway repairs – 2
- Porch reconstruction – 1
