DIRECTIONS:

Traveling I-84 West. Take the Main Street Exit. Pass through one light and at the next light, turn right onto Main Street. Continue on Main Street about 1/4 mile, bearing left onto Albany Avenue (Route 44). Continue on Albany Avenue two to three miles until you get to Blue Hills Avenue (**McDonalds will be on the left**). Turn right onto Blue Hills Avenue. Travel six blocks (3 lights) and turn right onto Holcomb Street. Turn left into the driveway of the Oak Hill school and take a slight right and then left – follow road all the way around to the Auditorium building on the left.

Traveling I-84 East. Take the Main Street exit (Exit 50). At the end of the ramp, turn left. At the second light, turn left onto Main Street. Continue on Main Street about one block, bearing left onto Albany Avenue (Route 44). Continue on Albany Avenue two to three miles until you get to Blue Hills Avenue (**McDonalds will be on the left**). Turn right onto Blue Hills Avenue. Travel six blocks (3 lights) and turn right onto Holcomb Street. Turn left into the driveway of the Oak Hill school and take a slight right and then left – follow road all the way around to the Auditorium building on the left.
